Emergency water management	Rowena Dubberly is settling in well to the role of water monitor for the three lines. December was particularly busy for water. All people needing water were able to access it. The issue of the pump tripping for some Richard Rd residents is ongoing and instances are being logged. No resolution in sight at this time. The issue of the system not registering a payment for water when a late fee has also been charged has been rectified. John Courmadias has been offered and verbally accepted the contract as water manager. Transport of plumber to SI Emergency Water repairs	The plumber and tools usually need to be transported to the site of a repair. The community vehicle is usually booked for this purpose, though no payment has been made to the drivers in the past, it being a SIRA expense. This is a disincentive for drivers. It is proposed that the Emergency Water proceeds fund the trips by drivers to deliver the plumber to and from jobs.	Raise at 4 February meeting. May also apply to the maintenance person
Storage of materials / supplies and tools for SI Emergency Water repairs and maintenance	The materials / supplies and tools for SI Emergency Water repairs and maintenance need to be in a central place so they can be accessed by the repair person. They are currently located at Cass and Bill's at the top of the island	Marie to follow up with Northern Beaches Council the possible secure storage of water line supplies under the community hall
SIRA and SI community websites	Information on the websites to be reviewed and renewed where necessary	Marie and John to work on this
