Emergency water management	<p>Rowena Dubberly is settling in well to the role of water monitor for the three lines.</p> <p>December was particularly busy for water.</p> <p>All people needing water were able to access it.</p> <p>The issue of the pump tripping for some Richard Rd residents is ongoing and instances are being logged. No resolution in sight at this time.</p> <p>The issue of the system not registering a payment for water when a late fee has also been charged has been rectified.</p> <p>John Courmadias has been offered and verbally accepted the contract as water manager.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cass to schedule a training session for John week commencing 12 February and process for hand over of responsibilities and relevant documentation and contacts • Marie, Robert, Rowena and John to meet to discuss water booking process, ongoing issues and monitor/manager roles following signing of contract • Marie and John to gain access to the water app following signing of contract •
Transport of plumber to SI Emergency Water repairs	<p>The plumber and tools usually need to be transported to the site of a repair.</p> <p>The community vehicle is usually booked for this purpose, though no payment has been made to the drivers in the past, it being a SIRA expense. This is a disincentive for drivers.</p> <p>It is proposed that the Emergency Water proceeds fund the trips by drivers to deliver the plumber to and from jobs.</p>	<p>Raise at 4 February meeting.</p> <p>May also apply to the maintenance person</p>
Storage of materials / supplies and tools for SI Emergency Water repairs and maintenance	<p>The materials / supplies and tools for SI Emergency Water repairs and maintenance need to be in a central place so they can be accessed by the repair person. They are currently located at Cass and Bill's at the top of the island</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Marie to follow up with Northern Beaches Council the possible secure storage of water line supplies under the community hall
SIRA and SI community websites	<p>Information on the websites to be reviewed and renewed where necessary</p>	<p>Marie and John to work on this</p>
